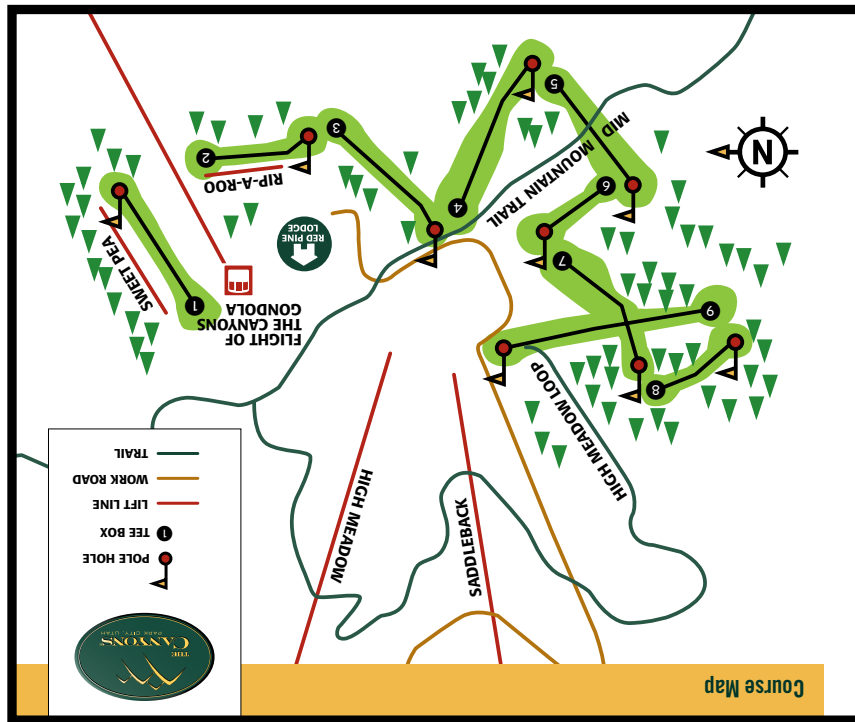


- 1 Starting from the top of Sweet Pea, this 390 ft./Par 3 is a straight shot down the run – Make sure to contact gondola operator before retrieving discs from roped area on right.
- 2 Throwing from the bottom of Rip-A-Roo this 354 ft./Par 3 is an uphill dogleg to the left.
- 3 This 280 ft./Par 3 hole takes you through the woods and over the river downhill on a narrow path. Bridge across the river is on the right-hand side.
- 4 An uphill 340 ft./Par 3 is wide open to the base of a small hill – Basket is against the trees on the left-hand side.
- 5 Slight uphill 325 ft./Par 3 – Basket is in a clearing on the left-hand side.
- 6 Fairway crosses the Mid Mountain trail – Keep an eye out for hikers/bikers.
- 7 This is an up and down 210 ft./Par 3 – A lay-up shot to the top of the hill gives you a clear view of the basket. Bold players can throw for a birdie by using the right-hand trees as a guide.
- 8 Traversing Sidewinder, this 340 ft./Par 3 has a slight dogleg to the right. Your first shot should be just to the right of the aspens uphill on the left-hand side.
- 9 Slight dogleg to the left on this 260 ft./Par 3 – Shoot over the small trees and rocks to the clearing above.
- 10 Bombs away on this 540 ft./Par 4 straight down Sidewinder to Red Pine Lodge. Two long throws can do it, but be careful not to overshoot the basket located on creek bank.

Rules of Play

- Please respect hikers, bikers and wildlife. Do not throw when others are in the way of your shot.
- Tee throws must be completed within the designated tee area.
- After teeing off, the player whose disc is farthest from the hole always throws first. The player with the least amount of strokes on the previous hole is first to tee-off on the next hole.
- Fairway throws must be made with the foot closest to the hole on the front edge of the lie where the last throw landed. The other foot may be no closer to the hole than the foot on this lie.
- A run-up and normal follow-through, after release is allowed more than 10 meters from the hole. Inside the 10 meters, a player may not step past the point of their lie until after the disc has landed.
- A disc that comes to rest inside the Disc Pole Hole basket or chains constitutes a successful completion of that hole. A disc that comes to rest on top of the Pole Hole does not constitute successful completion.
- Any disc that comes to rest more than 2 meters above the ground is considered unplayable. The disc must be thrown from directly below the disc. (1 throw penalty).
- A disc that is thrown out-of-bounds (e.g. bike path, road, or in the water), must be thrown from the point where the disc went out-of-bounds.

Important Information

- The Flight of The Canyons gondola is open Thursdays–Sundays 10:00 am–4:00 pm. Last gondola ride is 4:00 pm. Please allow yourself ample time to return to top of gondola.
- The fire danger is extreme! Smoking is prohibited in all areas.
- Sheep grazing occurs on these mountains. Keep pets leashed at all times and avoid herd dogs as they may become aggressive.
- Please respect the land: Please respect public and private property; stick to the trails and please don't pick or trample plants.
- Please respect the wildlife: We share this mountain with the wildlife. Please observe animals from a respectful distance and don't feed them.
- Please respect the resources: Carry out trash you bring in or any you encounter along the way.
- Please respect the resort: Heed posted signs as they are there to guide and inform you as well as to protect you. Please respect them and leave them in place for the benefit of others. Please stay on designated trails.
- Please respect the air: Consider carpooling to The Canyons.
